ABOUT US

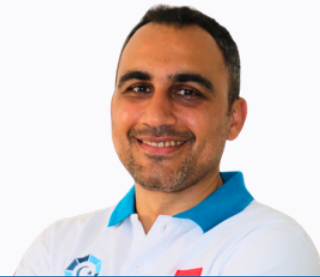

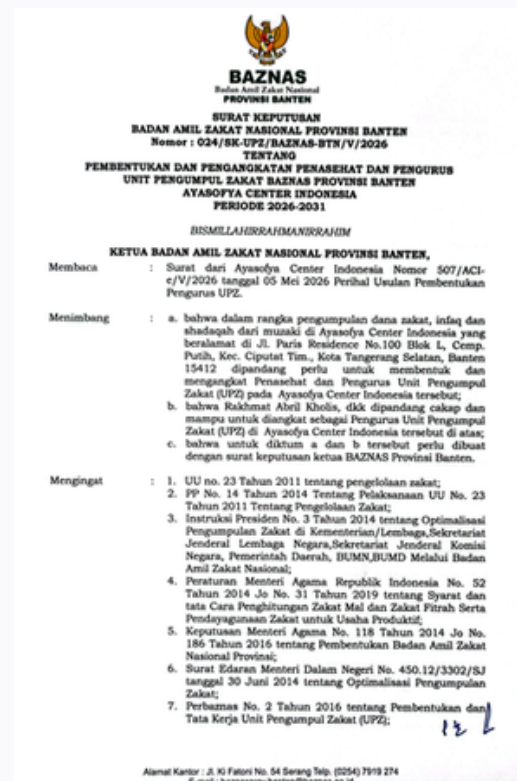
